## Community Education Counsellors

### Student Support

- Act as an advocate for students
- Encourage student engagement
- Welcome students into the school
- Involvement in re-entry process
- Provide advice on cultural/social information to students
- Member of student welfare/support groups
- Follow up on absenteeism
- Encouraging and assisting students with work experience
- Assisting students with subject selection

### Pastoral Care

- Provide educational counselling
- Encourage, recognise and reward students who are moving forward
- Facilitate student support
- Acknowledge and promote talented or quiet achievers
- Provide support to the SET planning process.

### Productive partnerships

- Input into school programs and committees
- Supporting and networking with other CEC's
- Sharing information and resources
- Shadowing/mentoring programs

### Teacher/Curriculum Support

- A support person for teachers
- Provide relevant family background information
- Encourage student participation in all aspects of school life
- Provide appropriate cultural information

- Provide advice on Indigenous cultural and social perspectives into the curriculum e.g. EATSIPS
- Provide a link between parents/community/school

### Parent & Community Liaison

- Facilitate home visits if required
- Support parents during parent/teacher interviews if required
- Identify and establish links with support services for Indigenous students
- Foster and maintain these networks
- Facilitate links with Elders and key Indigenous community persons
- Encourage parent involvement/ engagement with the school

### Cultural Activities

- Co-ordinate significant celebrations e.g. Close the GAP Day, Reconciliation Week, NAIDOC Week
- Work with the Indigenous Captain to Co-ordinate significant celebrations e.g. Close the Cap Day, NAIDOC Week & Sorry Day
- Facilitate the development of activities to enhance Indigenous students involvement
- Assist in providing cross-cultural training for the school community
- Access and provide opportunities to experience and get involved in cultural activities including Indigenous art, dance, yarning and storytelling
